SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

**LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT  
NEW LONDON, OHIO**

will be received by the Village of New London, Ohio, at the Office of the Village Administrator, 115 East Main Street, New London, Ohio 44851 until

2:00 p.m. (Local Time)  
Thursday, January 6, 2022

then the bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud in Village Council Chambers located at 12 James Street, New London, Ohio;

The scope of work for this project consists of the following:

Replace existing lead and/or galvanized service lines for 59 properties throughout the Village. Service line replacements will include new tap on existing water mains, curb valve & box, HDPE service line from water main to interior plumbing connection for each resident/structure, associated/necessary appurtenances, and restoration work at each service location.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Administrator for the Village of New London, Ohio and the Architect/Engineer -- Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). The documents may be viewed and ordered online or obtained from Becker Impressions, 4646 Angola Road, Toledo, Ohio 43615, Telephone 419-385-5303, [www.pdgplanroom.com](http://www.pdgplanroom.com) for the cost of printing to be paid to the printing company at the time the documents are picked up. Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions.

The Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked (as applicable) --- **LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT** --- and addressed to the Village of New London, 115 East Main Street, New London, Ohio 44851.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)

2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the Village of New London, Ohio in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs).

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Huron County, Ohio.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the highest applicable minimum wage rates as established by the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations issued by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The Village of New London, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

The use of domestic steel and Made In USA products will be required for all aspects/components of this project.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 90 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids. This project is being funded with Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) funding with Buy American requirements.

The opinion of probable cost of construction for the Lead Service Line Replacement Project is \$360,000.
