

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

### **MAUMEE FIRE AND POLICE TRAINING FACILITY – PHASE II FOR THE CITY OF MAUMEE, OHIO**

will be received by the **City of Maumee, Ohio, 400 Conant Street, Maumee, OH 43537, until 9:00 a.m., May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018**, and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Council Chambers.

**The project consists of construction of a police firing range and includes 50,635 c.y., of embankment, storm water pump station, sanitary sewer grinder pump, parking and drives, 1,100 s.y., of concrete pavement; and necessary appurtenances. The estimated cost of construction is \$1,027,000.00.**

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the City of Maumee, 400 Conant Street, Maumee, Ohio and the Engineer for the project - - Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., (PDG), 101 Clinton Street, Suite 1300, Defiance, OH 43512.

**The documents may be viewed and ordered online or obtained from Becker Impressions, 4646 Angola Road, Toledo, Ohio 43615, Telephone (419) 385-5303, [www.pdgplanroom.com](http://www.pdgplanroom.com) for the cost of printing to be paid to the printing company at the time the documents are picked up. Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions. Bidders must be on the official bidders list of PDG's Planroom in order to submit a bid.**

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked - - - **Bid for the MAUMEE FIRE AND POLICE TRAINING FACILITY PHASE II - - - and addressed to the City of Maumee Service Department, 400 Conant Street, Maumee, OH 43537.**

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the **City**, in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is 100% payment and performance bond.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

Bids received after the scheduled bid opening date and time, or not accompanied by a satisfactory bid bond or check, will neither be read nor considered.

The **City of Maumee** reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of **60** days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.
