

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the Water Treatment Plant Replacement will be received by the Village of Hamler at their offices at 871 East Hubbard Street, Hamler, Ohio 43524 until 11:00 a.m. (Local Time), Wednesday, April 18, 2018 and then at 11:01 a.m. at said office opened and read aloud.

The scope of work to be performed consists of the construction of a new water treatment plant with aeration, iron removal, filtration, ion exchange softeners, and other required components.

The Architect/Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 100% of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the aforesaid Village of Hamler, Ohio or by certified check, cashiers check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount in favor of the aforesaid Village of Hamler, Ohio. Bid Bonds shall be accompanied by Proof of Authority of the official or agent signing the bond.

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for payment bond and performance bond for 100% of the contract price. The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the highest applicable minimum wage rates as established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio and the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations issued by the U.S. Department of Labor.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within ninety (90) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Village of Hamler, Ohio reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

This project is being partially funded with Federal CDBG, DEFA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account, and OPWC funds. The opinion of probable cost of construction for this project is \$1,550,000. This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs).
