The scope of work consists of wastewater treatment plant improvements including final clarifier upgrades and an additional clarifier, new headworks/screening facility, new raw sewage pump station, new UV disinfection, a new generator, and a miscellaneous pumps, piping, valves, and gates.

The Engineer's Estimate for the cost of construction is \$5,350,000.

**and construction materials. The de minimis and minor components waiver (*to be determined on a case by case basis*) apply to this contract.**
