SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

**WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS
CONTRACT A – 100,000 GALLON ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK
AND/OR
CONTRACT B – WATERLINE IMPROVEMENTS**

will be received by the Village of West Unity, 224 West Jackson Street, West Unity, Ohio 43570 until

11:00 a.m. (Local Time)
Wednesday, August 21, 2019

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work consists of two contracts. Contract A consists of the installation of a 100,000 gallon elevated storage tank, demolition of the old existing elevated tank, and installation of an altitude valve at the existing 300,000 gallon elevated tank. There are two (2) sites possible for the proposed tank. The contract will be awarded to the lowest bidder for either Site 1 or Site 2. Contract B consists of the installation of approximately 500 lineal feet of 12" waterline and appurtenances.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Village of West Unity, Ohio and the Architect/Engineer -- Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). The documents may be viewed and ordered online or obtained from Becker Impressions, 4646 Angola Road, Toledo, Ohio 43615, Telephone 419-385-5303, www.pdgplanroom.com for the cost of printing to be paid to the printing company at the time the documents are picked up. Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions.

The Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS: CONTRACT A – 100,000 GALLON ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK AND/OR CONTRACT B – WATERLINE IMPROVEMENTS** --- and addressed to the Village of West Unity, 224 West Jackson Street, West Unity, Ohio 43570.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the West Unity, Ohio in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs).

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Williams County, Ohio.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

The Village of West Unity, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids. This project is being partially funded with Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) funds and Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) with Buy American requirements.

The estimated cost of construction is \$1,032,000 for Contract A and \$93,100 for Contract B.
