

INVITATION TO BID

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

**MADISON STREET AND KITTLE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION
VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO**

will be received by Village of Holland, Ohio at the office of the Clerk/Treasurer, Village of Holland, 1245 Clarion Avenue, Holland, Ohio 43528 until

12:00 NOON (LOCAL TIME)
FRIDAY, MARCH 15, 2019

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work consists of the complete reconstruction of approximately 800 feet of Madison Street and Kittle Road in the Village of Holland. In addition to the reconstruction, the project includes curb and gutter installation, new concrete drive aprons, sidewalk and storm sewers as well as related work.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Village of Holland and the Engineer - Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). Documents may be viewed and ordered online or obtained by Becker Impressions, 4646 Angola Road, Toledo, Ohio 43615, Telephone 419-385-5303, www.pdgplanroom.com. The cost of printing is to be paid to the printing company at the time the drawings are picked up. Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions.

The Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **VILLAGE OF HOLLAND - MADISON STREET AND KITTLE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION**--- and addressed to Lyn Krasula, Clerk/Treasurer at the 1245 Clarion Avenue, Holland, Ohio 43528.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the Village of Holland, in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Lucas County, Ohio.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

The Village of Holland reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The estimate for the cost of construction is \$372,000.
