Separate sealed BIDS for the installation of the McComb Contract A - Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements #2800 will be received by the Northwestern Water and Sewer District at the office of the District Engineer, 12560 Middleton Pike, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402 until 11:00 a.m. (Local Time), Thursday, May 31, 2018 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work for Contract A consists of a new wastewater treatment plant with suction lift pumps, mechanical screen, oxidation ditch, two (2) clarifiers, submersible pumps, UV disinfection, post aeration, two (2) digesters, two (2) sludge beds, and an Administration Building.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the applicable minimum wage rates as established by the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations issued by the U.S. Department of Labor.

This project is being partially funded with monies from USDA Rural Development.

The Engineer's Estimate for the cost of construction is \$6,550,000 for Contract A.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete,

and construction materials. The de minimis and minor components waiver (*to be determined on a case by case basis*) apply to this contract.
