Sealed bids will be received by the Erie County Commissioners in Room 327, 2900 Columbus Avenue, Sandusky, Ohio 44870 not later than 9:30 a.m., local time, September 19, 2019, as per O.R.C. 307.86 et seq., and opened immediately thereafter for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

HURON BASIN WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY SLUDGE DEWATERING IMPROVEMENTS INSTALLATION ERIE COUNTY, OHIO

The scope of work consists of installation of a sludge dewatering centrifuge, structural steel platform, and polymer feed system within the existing service building at the WPCF.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Board of Erie County Commissioners and the Architect/Engineer -- Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions.

The Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

A pre-bid meeting has been scheduled for Thursday, September 5, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. at the Huron Basin, 554 River Road, Huron, Ohio 44839. Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **HURON BASIN WPCF SLUDGE DEWATERING IMPROVEMENTS INSTALLATION**--- and addressed to the Board of Erie County Commissioners, 2900 Columbus Avenue, Room 327, Sandusky, Ohio 44870.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the Erie County Board of Commissioners in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Erie County, Ohio.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

Erie County, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The estimated cost of construction is \$390,000.
