SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

**RAW WATER INTAKE, PUMP STATION, AND RAW WATERLINE  
LEIPSIC/GILBOA, OHIO

will be received by the Village of Leipsic, 142 East Main Street, Leipsic, Ohio 45856 until

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work consists of the following:

Contract A – Raw Water Intake and Pump Station includes: Site clearing and grubbing; reinforced concrete raw water intake structure; 42" raw water intake pipe; reinforced concrete wet well and piping gallery; pump station building; vertical turbine raw water pumps (4); raw water piping, fittings, and valves; mechanical heating, ventilating, and air conditioning electrical power, instrumentation, and control; and site work including chain link fence and aggregate access drive.

Contract B – 24" Raw Waterline includes: Install 33,201 lineal feet of 24" raw waterline; state highway crossings by boring with casing; railroad crossing by boring with casing; stream crossing by boring without casing; miscellaneous fittings and valves; air release manhole(s); miscellaneous storm sewer repairs; pavement repair; asphalt pavement overlay; and seeding and mulching.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Village of Leipsic, Ohio and the Architect/Engineer -- Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). The documents may be viewed and ordered online or obtained from Becker Impressions, 4646 Angola Road, Toledo, Ohio 43615, Telephone 419-385-5303, [www.pdgplanroom.com](http://www.pdgplanroom.com) for the cost of printing to be paid to the printing company at the time the documents are picked up. Shipping and tax charges are the bidder's responsibility and payable directly to Becker Impressions.

A Pre-Bid Meeting has been scheduled for Monday, April 16, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. at the Village Hall, 142 East Main Street, Leipsic, Ohio 45856. Bidders are encouraged to attend.

The Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **RAW**

**WATER INTAKE, PUMP STATION, AND RAW WATERLINE** --- and addressed to the Village of Leipsic, 142 East Main Street, Leipsic, Ohio 45856.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the Village of Leipsic in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Putnam County, Ohio.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the highest applicable minimum wage rates as established by the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations issued by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The Village of Leipsic, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids. This project will be partially funded with Federal funds from the United States Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration and therefore is subject to the Federal laws and regulations associated with that program.

The estimated cost of construction is \$4,022,786 for Contract A and \$9,109,000 for Contract B.
