

INVITATION TO BID

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the

DUNN DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE 1 VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO

will be received by the Village of Holland, Ohio at the office of the Clerk/Treasurer, Village of Holland, 1245 Clarion Avenue, Holland, Ohio 43528 until

**11:00 A.M. (LOCAL TIME)
FRIDAY, MAY 23, 2008**

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work consists of the complete reconstruction of Dunn Drive, east of Clark Street, a distance of over 1,600 feet. In addition to new pavement, the work includes curb and gutter, sidewalks, a new 8" water main and appurtenances, a new storm sewer and related work.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Village of Holland, Ohio, and the Engineer -- Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG). To obtain a set of the contract documents, please submit a non-refundable check to PDG for \$50.00 made payable to the Village of Holland, Ohio.

The Engineer for the Project is Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc., 1168 North Main Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402.

All bids must be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in this booklet. Bids must state the unit prices in the blanks provided and be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked --- **DUNN DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE 1** --- and addressed to the Village of Holland, Attn: Clerk/Treasurer, 1245 Clarion Avenue, Holland, Ohio 43528.

The bid guaranty may be of two forms:

1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in the Contract Documents. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.)
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the Village of Holland, Ohio, in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond.

After the award of the contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, bidders shall submit the affidavit required under the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5719.042 that the bidder was not charged with any delinquent personal property taxes in Lucas County, Ohio.

The successful bidder will be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio.

The Village of Holland, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid and to determine the lowest and best bidder.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.001 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.001 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The estimated cost of construction is \$545,000.
