The information below summarizes the programs and opportunities.

State Capital Improvement Program

Eligible projects are for improvements to roads, bridges, culverts, water supply systems, wastewater systems, storm water collection systems, and solid waste disposal facilities. Funding is provided through grants, loans, and loan assistance or local debt support. Grants are available for up to 90% of the total project costs for repair/replacement, and up to 50% for new/expansion. Loans can be provided for up to 100% of the project costs. Grant/loan combinations are also available. There is no minimum or maximum loan amount. The term of the loan cannot exceed the useful life of the project, or thirty years, whichever is less. The minimum term is one year. The District will recommend the rate of interest for each loan in whole percent increments from 0 to 3 percent. Once the project is completed a final amortization schedule is provided requiring payments every January and July until the term of the loan expires. Loans may be paid in full with no prepayment penalty.

Local Transportation Improvement Program

The Local Transportation Improvement Program was created by the legislature in 1989 and provides the equivalent of one cent in gasoline tax receipts annually (currently approximately \$61 million). Since the use of such receipts is constitutionally limited to roads and bridges only counties, cities, villages and townships may apply for these funds. Applicants may apply for grants up to 100% of the project cost. This is only a grant
